# Autumn ITN Progression Night Tournament Series



## CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. These tournaments are approved by Tennis Queensland and shall be conducted in accordance with the Rules of the Game adopted by Tennis Australia, the Tournament Rules & Regulations laid down by Tennis Queensland and the Tennis Australia Code of Conduct.
2. Entry is restricted to players who are 2007 members of The University of Queensland Tennis Club Inc.
3. The Tournament Management Committee, hereinafter referred to as the "Committee", shall have the entire control and management of the tournament. Any matter not specifically covered by these Conditions shall be resolved by the Committee, whose decision shall be final.
4. The entry level into the Autumn Tournament Series is determined by the player's International Tennis Number (ITN). For most members, ITNs have been assigned on the basis of Fixture and Tournament Results. New members have been assigned a Provisional ITN on the basis of a Grading Session. If, in the opinion of the Committee, a player nominates for the wrong level starting tournament, he/she will automatically be moved to the level tournament considered appropriate by the Committee.
5. Players must start in the Tournament as designated for their ITN ranking. This means an ITN 7 (or lower) male or an ITN 6 (or lower) female must start in the 17 March Tournament; an ITN 6 male or an ITN 5 female must start in the 24 March Tournament; an ITN 5 male or an ITN 4 female must start in the 21 April Tournament; and an ITN 4 (or higher) male or an ITN 3 (or higher) female may only play on 28 April.
6. Entries must be submitted on the prescribed entry form. Each player must complete a separate entry form which must be completed in full, signed to confirm acceptance of the Tournament Conditions and lodged with the \$20 entry fee by Wednesday 14 March. Notwithstanding this rule, the Tournament Committee may, at its absolute discretion, accept a late entry for a particular tournament as long as the player is eligible for that tournament (i.e. an ITN 6 male player could lodge a late entry after 17 March and before 24 March, but an ITN 7 male could not). Entries must be sent to the UQ Tennis Club. Entries may be hand delivered; posted to the UQ Tennis Club, PO Box 6005, St Lucia, Qld 4067; faxed to 3870 5002 (with credit card payment); or e-mailed to [admin@uqtc.org.au](mailto:admin@uqtc.org.au) (with credit card payment).
7. A top 6 finisher in the 17 March Tournament will automatically be included in the draw for the 24 March Tournament; a top 6 finisher in the 24 March Tournament will automatically be included in the draw for the 21 April Tournament; and a top 6 finisher in the 21 April Tournament will automatically be included in the draw for the 28 April Tournament. The \$20 entry fee covers a player for the Series, irrespective of the number of tournaments played.
8. Payment may be made by Cash, Cheque, Money Order, Credit Card (\$4 credit card service fee applies) or EFTPOS (\$2 debit card service fee applies). If paying by cheque or money order, make payable to The University of Queensland Tennis Club Inc. (or UQ Tennis Club). Credit card payments may be made by post or fax by completing the authority below (MasterCard or Visa Card only).
9. Any player may withdraw prior to the draw being made and the entry fee less relevant administrative expenses shall be refunded. No entry fees shall be refunded where a player is defaulted or where a player withdraws after being placed in the draw and the courts booked.
10. Players of all standards and genders will compete in a single event, although the Committee reserves the right to divide players into groups with play-offs between group winners to determine over-all winners.
11. The event will be played using a round-robin format which guarantees that all entrants get multiple matches. The exact format will be decided by the Committee when the entry numbers are known.
12. Each match shall consist of one set but players shall be permitted a warm-up period of 3 minutes prior to their first set only.
13. Each set shall be won by the player first to reach 6 games. If the score reaches 5 games all, the set shall be decided by a sudden-death tie-break. As an alternative, if entries numbers are high or low, 'short' sets or 'pro' sets may be used. In a short set, the set is won by the player first to reach 4 games, with a sudden-death tie-break if the score reaches 3 games all. In a pro set, the set is won by the player first to reach 9 games, with a sudden death tie-break if the score reaches 8 games all.
14. In any game, if the score reaches Deuce twice, a sudden-death point shall be played to decide the game. The sudden-death point is served to the court nominated by the receiver.
15. In the sudden-death tie-break, the player whose turn it is to serve, serves two points and, thereafter each player serves two points in rotation and in the same order as previously in the set. This continues until one player/pair reaches 5 points. If the score reaches 4-all, the player who has just served, shall serve the deciding point to the court nominated by the receiver.
16. All players must report to the Tournament Office 15 minutes before the scheduled start of play (i.e. by 6:45 p.m.). Entrants not ready to play at 7 p.m. may be defaulted. Play will be scheduled to finish at 10:30 p.m. but, if necessary, play may be extended until 11 p.m.
17. In the event of rain preventing play on any Saturday, the tournament will be played on the following Saturday; and, if another level tournament was already scheduled for that Saturday, that Tournament in turn will be postponed to the following Saturday (unless notified otherwise).
18. Prizes will be awarded for the best performed male and female players in each Tournament.
19. Tournaments in the Autumn Series are Category A Tournaments in the 2007 UQ Tennis Club Grand Prix. For players who progress from one level tournament to the next level tournament, Grand Prix Points will be calculated for both tournaments with the higher Points awarded.
