CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. This tournament is approved by Tennis Queensland and shall be conducted in accordance with the Rules of the Game adopted by Tennis Australia, the Tournament Rules & Regulations laid down by Tennis Queensland, the Tennis Australia Events Disciplinary Policy and the UQ Tennis Club Code of Conduct.
2. This tournament is being run by The University of Queensland Tennis Club Inc. (UQ Tennis Club). Entry is restricted to players who are members of the UQ Tennis Club for 2008.
3. The Tournament Management Committee, hereinafter referred to as the "Committee", shall have the entire control and management of the tournament. Any matter not specifically covered by these Conditions shall be resolved by the Committee, whose decision shall be final.
4. Wilson Australian Open Tennis Balls will be used in this tournament.
5. Entries must be submitted on the prescribed entry form. Each pair must complete a separate entry form which must be completed in full, signed by at least one player to confirm acceptance of the Tournament Conditions and lodged with the entry fees by 11 p.m. on Thursday 2 October, 2008. Entries must be sent to the UQ Tennis Club. Entries may be hand delivered; posted to the UQ Tennis Club, PO Box 6005, St Lucia, Qld 4067; faxed to 3870 5002 (with credit card payment); or e-mailed to admin@uqtc.org.au (with credit card payment).
6. Payment may be made by Cash, Cheque, Money Order, Credit Card (\$4 credit card service fee applies) or Debit Card (\$2 debit card service fee applies). If paying by cheque or money order, make payable to The University of Queensland Tennis Club Inc. (or UQ Tennis Club). Credit card payments (but not Debit Card payments) may be made by post or fax by completing the authority below (MasterCard or Visa Card only).
7. Entries will only be accepted from pairs.
8. Any pair may withdraw prior to entries being finalised and the entry fee less relevant administrative expenses shall be refunded. No entry fees shall be refunded where a pair is defaulted or where a pair withdraws after entries are finalised and the courts booked.
9. Where a player's partner is unable to play, a substitute partner of an appropriate standard may be obtained, with the approval of the Committee, at any time prior to the first match. No substitutes will be permitted after the commencement of a pair's first match.
10. The tournament will be conducted using four levels – Open (open to all players), A Grade (equivalent to ITN 5 or lower level), B Grade (equivalent to ITN 6 or lower level) and C Grade (equivalent to ITN 7 or lower level). Level eligibility shall be decided on the basis of the ITNs allocated by the Club Grading Committee. Players may enter the event equivalent to their ITN ratings or any event at a higher level. Players who do not nominate a level shall be entered in the event equivalent to their ITNs. Where partners are of different standards, level eligibility shall be decided by the higher standard. Depending on entry numbers, the Committee reserves the right to cancel any event or amalgamate events, to divide any event into sections and to determine the number of prizes to be awarded.)
11. The tournament will be played using Round-Robin formats which guarantee that all entrants get multiple matches because players keep playing irrespective of whether they win or lose. Depending on numbers, pairs in a level may be split into groups with play-offs to determine final positions. The exact format for each event shall be decided by the Committee when the entry numbers are known.
12. Each match shall consist of one tie-break set. Sets may be Short Sets, Normal Sets or Pro Sets as announced by the Committee at the start of play. Serve and ends shall be decided by toss. Players shall be permitted a warm-up period of 3 minutes prior to their first match only.
13. A Short Set is won by the first player to win 4 games but, if the score reaches 3 games all, a Tie-Break will be played to decide the set. A Normal Set is won by the first player to win 6 games but, if the score reaches 5 games all, a Tie-Break will be played to decide the set. A Pro Set is won by the first player to win 9 games but, if the score reaches 8 games all, a Tie-Break will be played to decide the set.
14. **All players must report to the Tournament Office at least 15 minutes before the scheduled start of play (i.e. by 8:45 a.m.). A briefing about the playing formats to be used will be conducted at 8:50 a.m. Entrants not ready to play at 9 a.m. shall be defaulted.**
15. In the event of rain preventing play on Sunday 12 October, the tournament will be played on Sunday 19 October (9 a.m. to 2 p.m.).
