

Queensland Championships

UQ Tennis Centre coaches, past and present, took out most of the major Titles in the **2002 Rebound Ace Queensland Open Tennis Championships** played at the University of Queensland Tennis Centre on 20-21 & 27-28 July.

The coaches, **Lisa Argent**, **Kelli Orford** and **Andrew Orford**, won three Queensland Titles. Argent achieved the rare feat of winning triple championships.

103 players contested the Open Men's Singles and 39 players contested the Open Ladies' Singles.

John James won the Open Men's Singles Championship of Queensland, defeating Mark Draper (No. 5 seed) in the Final 7/5 6/0.

James, the No. 1 seed and defending champion, did not lose a set in the Singles Championship main draw and reached the Final by defeating David Campbell 6/0 6/0, Stuart Williams 6/0 7/6, Yuki Suga 6/4 7/5 and Ben Mathias 7/6 7/6.

Lisa Argent won the Open Ladies' Singles Championship of Queensland, defeating Linda Fallon (No. 1 seed and defending champion) in the Final 6/3 6/3.

Argent, the No. 6 seed, reached the Final by defeating Kayla Berry 6/3 6/4, Marinette Morgan 6/0 6/0, Ivana Jovanovich 6/4 2/6 6/1 and Jean Willmann w/o.

In the Open Doubles Finals, John James & Ben Mathias defeated Mark Draper & Jason Sellin 6/4 6/4 (OMD), Lisa Argent & Kelli Orford defeated Linda Fallon & Kelli Zahmel 6/2 6/2 (OLD) and Lisa Argent & Andrew Orford defeated Lisa Mackey & Stuart Williams w/o (OXD).

In the Junior Finals (18 & Under), Michael Leong defeated Simon Petrie 6/3 4/6 6/3 (18BS), Katrina Domela defeated Kartika Halim 6/2 7/6 (18GS) and Daniel Dossetor & Felix Koch defeated Armen Avetisyan & Jonathan Plante 6/0 6/1 (18BD).

The Rebound Ace Queensland Open was played in conjunction with the Rebound Ace University Open Championships (13-14, 20-21 & 27-28 July). 440 individual players competed in 39 events for over \$10,000 in prizemoney, trophies & prizes.

Q & A

Question: In a recent match, the Visiting Team supplied used balls for the match. What could we do?

Answer: In all Fixtures in which UQ competes, the Visiting Team is required to supply three new balls (of a brand approved by Tennis Australia). Teams turning up without new balls are treated in the same way as a team whose players turn up late. Generally, this means that play does not start until new balls are supplied and a team may claim the first set on forfeit after five minutes and the second set after another fifteen minutes have elapsed if new balls have still not been produced.
